1. G UW 3.1.1.
2. G UW 6.1.4. Test your queries in MySQL on the sample data.
3. G UW 6.1.5. Test your answers on the relation `NullExample` in the sample data.
4. G UW 6.2.1. Test your queries in MySQL on the sample data (NB: Download new data if you downloaded the old version, before Sept. 5).
5. G UW 6.2.3 c), e), and f). Test your queries in MySQL on the sample data. (NB: SQL's UNION and INTERSECT operators were not supported by the installed version of MySQL at the time of writing this, so you may not be able to try everything out.)
6. G UW 6.5.2 a), b), and d). Test the updates in MySQL on the sample data (without using the web interface to generate the SQL).
7. G UW 6.6.2. Create the relations in MySQL by typing SQL commands (i.e., without using the web interface to generate the SQL).
